Ngaruawahia Regatta (Saturday) Racing Rules

1. **Gold Coin Entry into the Regatta – this is not included in your entry fee for Kopapa or W1 Taupiri Dash**
2. All life-jackets, paddles (except for W1's), waka kopapa and waka ama will be provided
3. A maximum of FOUR teams per marae – one per division - will be allowed!
4. Risk Management & Safety Action Plan will be displayed at the registration tent on the day – please make sure to read before racing begins
5. No protesting – Race Director (Waki) will have the final say!
6. No crossing lanes allowed
7. No inappropriate behaviour or language – please have respect for the kaupapa!
8. ***Taupiri Dash – OC1***
 - All OC1's can be transported through 'Kirkwood's Paddock Parking' (signposted)
 - Safety check of waka will be administered prior to racing
 - Race will start after the Waka Taua Parade
 - OC1 Paddlers to register by 9am
 - Entry fee is \$10 per paddler
 - Number will be provided by Race Director for each waka
 - No vehicles will be allowed through main gate – top of Papakainga – all vehicles must park in Kirkwood Parking – you may offload waka from this parking (close to OC1 designated area)
9. ***Kopapa Races (teams may enter both Kopapa and Marae Races)***
 - Four per lane
 - First two progress (straight knockouts)
 - \$20 per team
 - Maximum of 5 per waka – including steerer
10. ***Marae Races – Waka Ama – 6 per waka***
 - Four per lane
 - 3 males & 2 females per waka
 - provide own steerer or inform Waki if you need one
 - Adults can rudder steer only in primary & secondary mixed
 - Steerer – competent – regardless of gender
 - Minimum of two races
 - First two progress to DIV 1
 - 3rd & 4th in heats progress to DIV 2
 - Quarters or Semis are straight knock-outs
 - Overall Marae will be based on placings in Div 1 finals
 - Free Entry
