Venue

This is a reminder to ensure that we respect the Lake Karāpiro Might River Domain facilities at all times, including the campgrounds and car park etc. Please ensure you remove your rubbish each evening after racing and keep your area clean.

Spectator embankment

Regions are to co-ordinate their space and ensure tents are erected in such a way that it maximises space and viewing for everyone. (The short side of the tents must face the lake)

We will be marking out an area of the spectator bank on Friday 11th (parallel with the lake) that must be kept clear of all tents, structures or marquees. This is to allow for safe walking passage. it will look something like this:



Please remember that any tents or pop up structures erected on the sloping embankment will need to be put down for prize giving each day.

If tents (club or otherwise) are erected in the wrong area or in such a way that it does not maximise space we will ask that they are taken down.

Half Lanes

Uniforms

- Teams must have the same uniform (tops only)
- Except for W12 events where a combination of 2 x W6 team uniforms can be worn.
- Paddlers can wear caps or sunglasses without the entire crew needing to wear them.
- Uniforms must be worn when entering the marshalling area and remain on until the completion of the race.
- Paddlers may wear weather appropriate additional clothing underneath
- Regional or Club Uniforms may be worn for W1's
- Uniforms must be worn at the Medal Presentations

Team Changes

A reminder to all club reps

- As long as paddlers are on the club roster – the team may change right up until going through registration with their ID cards. This doesn't need to be physically changed online as long as they are **on the roster**
- The first 6 (or 12) paddlers that swipe their ID cards for the heats, must be the same paddlers to carry on through to the finals
- Any changes from Friday (11th) evening will need to be completed at the lake Sunday 13th at the admin desk from 2:00pm- 7:30pm or during the week.

It is going to be a hot week, but it may also rain. Please come prepared for the weather and bring lots of sunblock.
