


Thank you to all those who have registered for the Papa Alf Memorial race, we are truly excited for what promises to be a awesome event. Registrations have closed.

Races will be a round robin with progressions, there are 3 divisions whith semis and finals. Subject to race numbers we may run a point system that gives us extra races.

# Support Boats and W6 drop offs



W6's can be dropped off Saturday afternoon and lashed. There will be overnight security at venue.

There will be 3 safety boats on the day, but you are welcome to bring your V1 one down as extra support.

### Safety & first aid

There is currently some construction of the footpath at the venue. There are also many water hazards please keep an eye on young children who could fall into the lake. It is very deep and there are sharp rocks around the edge of the lake.



We will have first aid kits on site as well as first aiders, upstairs in the officials desk. Please ensure you bring any medical supplies you need for your paddlers. There is a waiver form that will need to be signed by each parent or caregiver.

In the event of an emergency there is a assmbley point on the map that is marked by a red cross.
