## **2020 LONG DISTANCE NATIONALS**

Te Waka o Aoraki in association with Waka Ama New Zealand (WANZ), Te Tau Ihu and local clubs are proud to host the 2020 Waka Ama Long Distance Nationals (LDNs) to be held in Waitohi- Picton Harbour off Shelley beach 24-26<sup>th</sup> April 2020. Please note – due to ANZAC Day (25<sup>th</sup>) falling on the Saturday of the event, racing will start after 12pm that day

## **2020 LDN PŌWHIRI**

The powhiri will take place on the 23<sup>rd</sup> April at 4pm at Waikawa Marae, our host will be Te Ātiawa o Te Waka a Māui. Check out their website for more information about the marae https://www.waikawamarae.com

#### **BACK UP RACE DAY**

If the weather or sea conditions make it unsafe to paddle any one of the allocated races then Sunday, 26<sup>th</sup> April 2020 is the back-up race day. Paddlers are advised to make plans to be available that day.

#### **ENTRY FEES**

The fees for all entries received prior to 7 April are:

# NOTE:

- If a senior paddler is entered in both the W6 and W1 Rudderless/W1 Ruddered races the entry fee payable is \$90.00.
- If a Junior paddler is entered in both the W6 and W1 Rudderless/W1 Ruddered races, the entry fee payable is \$60.00.
- Entry into a third event would cost a further \$30.00 for seniors and \$20.00 for Juniors ie: W6 + W1+W2 = \$120.00/Senior or \$80/Junior.

## **PENALTIES**

Any late additions/changes/withdrawals after the 7<sup>th</sup> April, a \$20 per paddler late fee will apply e.g. division changes, paddler swap, additions.

Any club that withdraws teams after being invoiced will still be charged the full entry fee.

All team entries are to be entered via the Waka Ama New Zealand website through your Club Coordinator.



#### **RACE DISTANCES AND COURSES**

All race courses are in the open water of the Picton Harbour. The race course will be set closer to the event based on the weather and ocean conditions to provide all paddlers with an enjoyable, challenging and safe experience.

#### **COMPETITORS ABILITY**

We are providing opportunities for experienced and capable crews and individuals in age categories from J16 and above. The term "experienced" means that teams and individuals have experience in open sea conditions. All Clubs are responsible for ensuring that all paddlers are competent in the divisions that they have been entered in to. The Race Director has the discretion to withdraw a team or an individual who is deemed to be unfit or unprepared to complete the race.

The short course race will provide an opportunity to those paddlers who are experienced but are unable to complete the senior distance – the short course events will not be eligible for medals.

## **VERIFICATIONS**

Please ensure you send verification documents through nice and early. All paddlers entered must be verified and affiliated in order to add their names to the club roster.



#### **RACE DIVISIONS**

All age groups are as outlined in the Waka Ama New Zealand Race Rules, rule 50.2. Note: J16 minimum age is 11 and J19 Competitors must be a minimum age of 16 in the year of competition.

- All New Zealand entrants must be from clubs who are affiliated to Waka Ama New Zealand.
- All paddlers must be verified in order to enter
- Entrants from overseas clubs are welcome to register for this event but will not be eligible for medals.
- The adaptive teams must comprise of 3 adaptive paddlers and 3 non-adaptive paddlers.
- Mixed W6 teams must be made up of 3 men and 3 women.
- Mixed W2 teams must be made up of 1 man and 1 woman
- Mixed W3 teams must have at least 1 woman

V1, OC1, OC2 please contact clubs directly in Te Waka o Aoraki if you want to hire a single or double waka. These would be very limited to access unless you know people directly in Te Waka o Aoraki region.

- Accompanied or unaccompanied waka ama trailers can be booked through the freight team calling 0800 162 322.
- You can use this for walk on passengers as well. Whoever the name is on the booking you will be required to show your NKOA ID at check in. Both NKOA ID cards will be accepted.

#### **ACCOMMODATION**

Waitohi- Picton township has lots of accommodation and there are also lodges, AirBNB, backpackers and a range of accommodation. Blenheim also has ample motels hotels another 25 km. There are local marae and wineries that also offer accommodation.

#### **AIRPORTS**

There are two airports close to Waitohi-Picton. Sounds Air, which is about a 10 minute drive from Waitohi-Picton and the other is in Wairau- Blenheim out at Woodbourne which is a good 35 minutes drive operated by Air NZ. Another is in Whakatū - Nelson which is a 2-hour drive to Waitohi-Picton.
