

# **EVENT UPDATE - 11 OCTOBER 2020**

Please read the below information regarding our up coming George Pomana Memorial Regatta.

#### **RACE REGISTRATIONS**

Reminder these are all online via WANZ online system. Registrations close Wednesday 14 October, followed by team rosters on Thursday 15 October. No registrations will be taken on the day - so get in quick to not miss out!

Please ensure club registration payments are made prior to event. NO PAY, NO RACE! Juniors \$5 per race (\$10 for both W1 & W6) Seniors \$20

All paddlers will receive a hangi pack at completion of their race/s

\*\*FAI VA'A V1 SPOT PRIZE\*\* this is inclusive for ALL junior paddlers J16 - J19 who enter, and complete a race on the day. One entry per paddler. You must be on site to claim. Prize will be drawn until claimed.

### RACE DAY REGISTRATIONS & BRIEFINGS

This will be open from 8am at Admin tent (see map for location). Please ensure waivers are completed for each paddler/team. You will then receive your Safety Check form and race number.

We will only be accepting race registrations for Race #1 first. Admin will open registration for Race #2 & #3 once the race before is complete. Please be patient.

NOTE: Slight change to original programme - race safety briefing and start times will move forward 1/2 hour - approx. times below:

Race 1 safety brief: 9.00am Race start: 10.00am (J16/J19 girls and boys)

Race 2a safety brief: 10.15am Race start: 10.45am (Senior women)
Race 2b safety brief: 11.30am Race start: 12.00pm (Senior men)

Race 3 safety brief: 1.15pm Race start: 1.45pm (J16/J19 girls and boys)

\*Race 3 will proceed if enough entries are received\*

\*\*Mixed teams will be accepted but will be entered into category dependant on boy:girl ratio i.e. 4 boys:2 girls - boys team.

## **ON-SITE PARKING**

We will have parking wardens to assist you when you arrive. Trailers with W6 will be given priority. All others will need to drop off W1 and find alternate parking on side streets - Greers Road or Beihlers Road (see map). Our loading bay team will assist with waka unload and load.

Coffee van will be onsite from the morning. TPHW will have a kai stall available also with goods to purchase. There will be no hangi for sale (paddlers only). We encourage you to bring a packed lunch.


#### SPOT PRIZES / PRIZEGIVING
