Note: The W6 24km is restricted to 16yrs+ - no paddlers under this age can enter Race 1.

Costs

- Race 1: W6 24km \$50pp (\$300 per waka)
- Race 2: W6 10km \$40pp (\$240 per waka)
- Race 3: W1 5km, W2 5km, W1 10km, W2 10km \$40pp

Note: Paddlers that enter Race 1 W6 24km & Race 2 W6 10km races will get free entry for themselves into Race 3 W1 5km or W2 5km or W1 10km or W2 10km. You must still process your entry in the system and automatic discount will apply to invoices.



All paddlers must be affiliated and competent to complete designated races. Courses will triangular, but subject to change by course director

Waka and trailers can be offloaded on Friday and placed on the beach above the high tide mark. Contact Danny Kaiawe on **021958378** for gate code and access. Race day gate code will be provided closer to day.

At the completion of the event, we will head to Whitiora Marae, Te Tii for prizegiving and dinner. Only paid paddlers will be fed. Supporters will need to request a food ticket at administration at the race venue.

Covid 19 policy

By using the online entry system this will help with the contact tracing systems. You will also be required to record your attendance either at the gate entrance, electronic or manually, or at administration or safety checkers tents. Vendors and other contractors will be required to do this also.

All online entries should be made through your club reps. This will help determine how many paddlers /waka are on the water and, hand on heart, ensure we can log you or your teams into the timer device for times and placings in all categories.
