Race Rules:

- Waka: Ki Uta Ki Tai Waka Challenge is a W6 event only. All waka must be fitted with spray skirts and carry two bailers, two spare paddles, spare strapping, and tow ropes, Depending on the conditions; life jackets may be required to be worn by all competitors. All crews must provide lifejackets and paddles or arrange to borrow from another club.
- Novice Crews: Will have less than one year's paddling experience and <u>must</u> have an experienced steerer and the option of an experienced paddler please respect this kaupapa as we are keen to see novice crews have the opportunity to build their capacity at these events. All novice paddlers must wear life jackets.
- Course: The course map provided is subject to change on the day and determined by conditions.
- Attire: Competitors must dress appropriately for colder conditions; polypropylenes are recommended.
 Competitors will be checked during safety checks to ensure they are wearing appropriate clothing for the conditions.
 NB: There will be a prize for "Best dressed" team get creative! In honour of Paora Adams.

^{*}Prizegiving meal included with registration and tickets will be distributed at registration table on the day of event

- Safety: The Race Director and officials have absolute control of the event and reserve the right to make changes to the event as required. They also have the right to withdraw any competitor or Waka which may endanger their own or others' safety.
- First Aid: A first aid station will be available onshore and a registered nurse will attend. A defibrillator (AED) will also be located at the first aid station.
- Support Boats: The Race Komiti have organised support boats in line with the requirements from Waka Ama New Zealand.


I declare that:
