

Compulsory Equipment:

The following equipment must be carried by all waka and will be checked at gear check

- 1 life jacket per paddler (must fit correctly)
- 2 bailers W6,
- 2 Spare paddle W6
- 25m Tow rope W6 attached ready for towing
- Spray skirt
- Cell phone in waterproof bag or VHF Radio on Channel 66

Race Course:

The race course will be decided on Friday the 14th and all teams will be contacted. If the race start will be at Tairua harbour. Then race registration and briefing will also be from Pauanui. It will more than likely be a northerly wind. If there happens to be a southerly the start will be in Whangamata.

Entrants:

The race is limited to 20 entries. First in first serve and teams with no proven history will need to provide sufficient results to prove their capability. This is not a have a go race.

Hazards:

Teams must be experienced and prepared for the worst. Teams will not be refunded if they do not make it to the start line. You will more than likely have to paddle through at least one breaking wave.

Bad weather:
