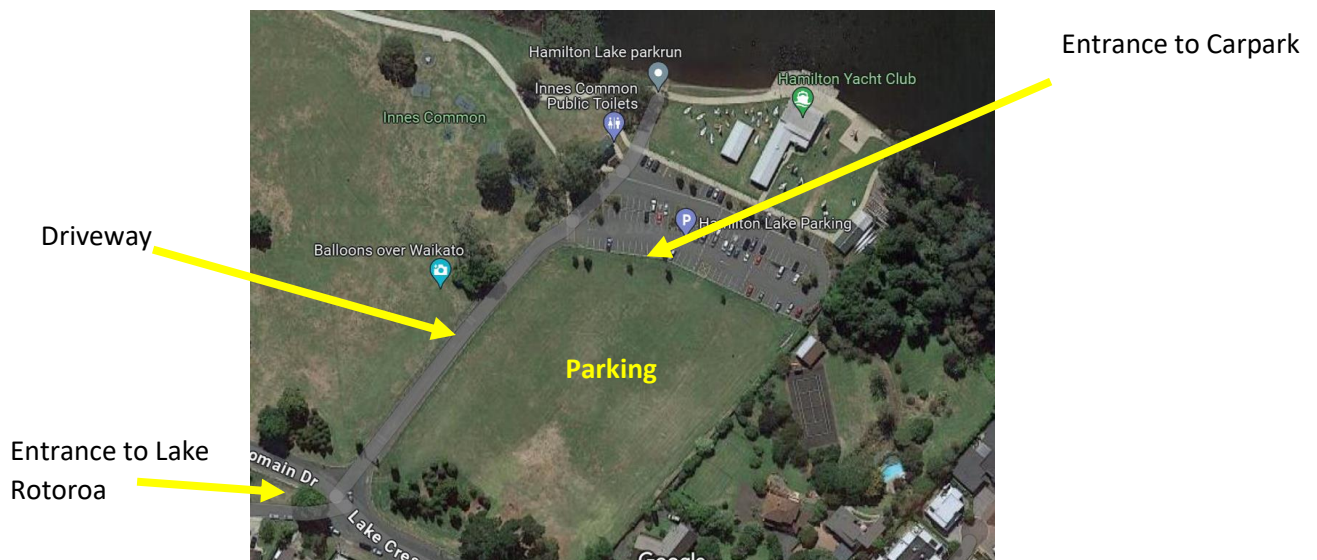

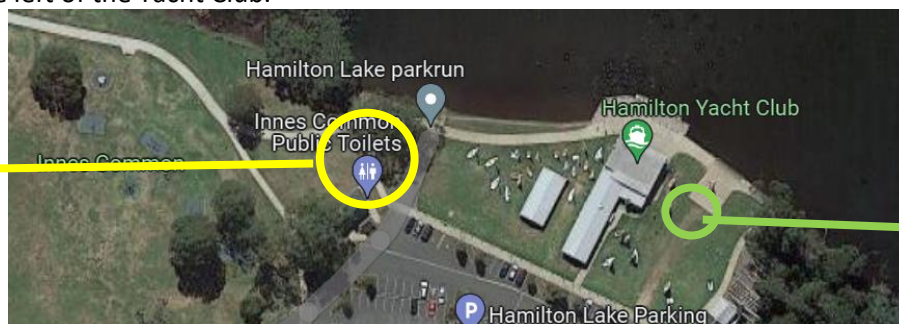

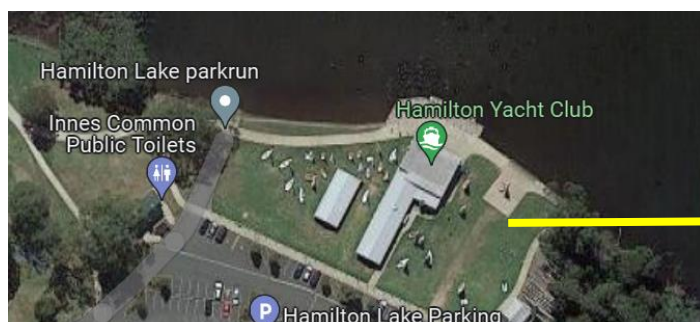
Alcohol/Smokefree:
