<u>Car Parking:</u> Parking is available by street parking. Please note all parking is under Auckland Council management, you will need to read the signs and park accordingly.

<u>Trailer parking:</u> Trailer parking available, designated grass area, Beaubank Road Carpark. **See site map**. Due to restrictions, this will only be available for trailer drop off – you will need to park your car elsewhere for the day.

<u>Food:</u> Paddler lunch will be provided, however a small range of food vendors will be available onsite to purchase healthy kai.

• All waka will have to pass a safety check and be marked before racing. Any boats not marked will not be permitted to race.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- All waka must be Safety Checked
- All taitamariki and intermediate age divisions must wear life jackets
- All Junior J16 must have the following safety equipment for their races:
 - PFD Personal Floatation Device (per person)
 - Bailers x 2
 - Spare Paddle 2 for a W6

TEAM WAIVERS

- Team waivers must be completed by all paddlers/teams
- All paddlers U18 must have their waiver signed by their parent/guardian
