RACE DAY INFORMATION

Car Parking: Parking is available in the reserve and between the reserve and the boat ramp. Roadside parking should be in a manner that **does not block** access to driveways. However, after recent weather events, erosion of the beach front is significant and we suggest parking at the **Tutukaka Marina and car pooling over to Kowharewa Bay.**

Trailer parking: Could all Waka trailers please be parked over at the Tutukaka Marina.

Food: We encourage you to bring your own healthy kai, our junior teams will have a kai stall as a fundraiser for nationals 2026. Coffee cart will be available on the day from 7am – 11:30am.

Toilets: Toilets are located in the reserve.

First Aid: First Aid will be available at the registration tent.

Rubbish/Recycling: We encourage you to please take what you bring. There are no rubbish facilities available at Kowharewa Bay.

Alcohol/Smokefree: Alcohol, smoking, vaping and any other substance use is not permitted.

Road Safety: We ask that whanau are mindful of the road and traffic during the day. It can get very congested during the day and the road can be very busy. We will have some road signs and cones out during the event.

WAKA DROP OFF & SAFETY CHECKS

Waka Drop off:

- Waka drop off will be available from Friday afternoon
- Waka drop off will be on the beach front via the boat ramp
- Trailer parking Tutukaka Marina

Safety Checks:

- All waka will have to pass a safety check and be marked before racing. Any boats not marked will not be permitted to race.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- All waka must be Safety Checked
- All taitamariki, intermediate and J16 age divisions must wear life jackets**
- All J19 and Senior (Open and above) must have the following safety equipment for their races:
 - PFD - Personal Floatation Device (per person)
 - Bailers x 2

INDIVIDUAL & TEAM WAIVERS

- Individual and Team waivers must be completed by all paddlers/teams
- All paddlers U18 must have their waiver signed by their parent/guardian
- Waivers can be handed in to Registration on the day

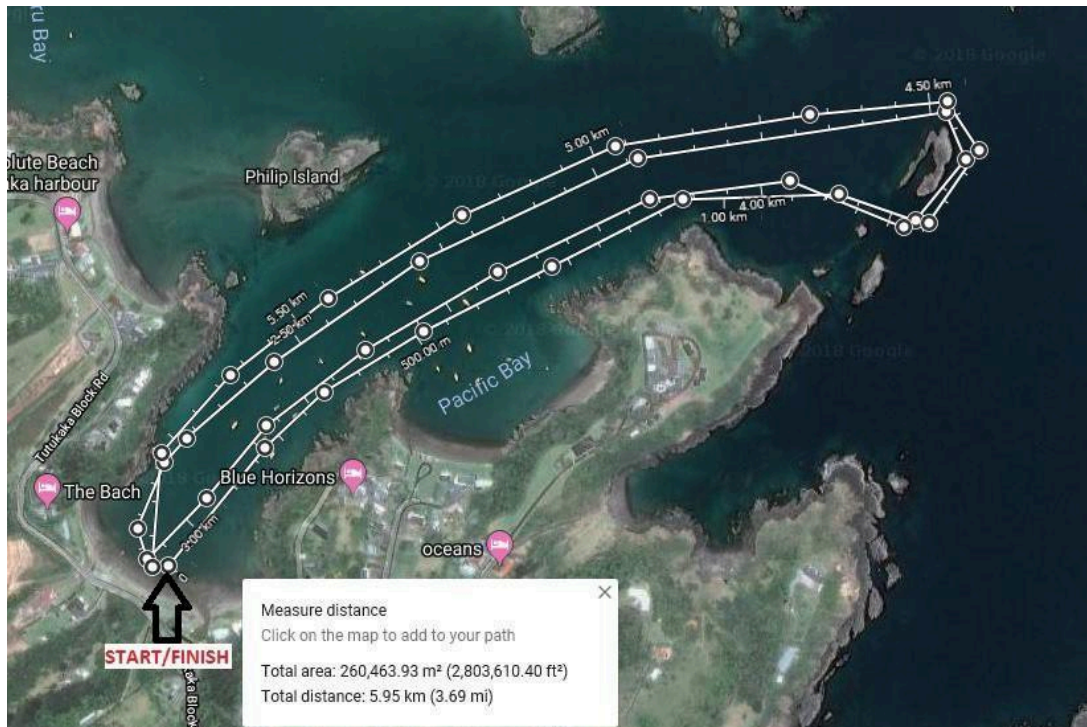
