

# Race Report: 2026 James (Bhutty) Moore-morial

## Ocean Mastery and Strategic Gambles at Mauao

The 2026 James (Bhutty) Moore-morial was more than just a race. It was a gathering of the paddling whānau to honour those we have lost. Before the paddles hit the water, the beach fell silent. We stood together for a moving moment of silence to remember **James (Bhutty) Moore**, alongside all those we have lost and those affected by the Mauao slip. This collective breath of remembrance reminded everyone why we gather each year, to celebrate life, community, and the moana.

## The "Wide Line" Strategy

The race was defined by the early decision to handle a tricky southerly wind. While the main pack stayed tight to the coastline, a group of veterans including **Johno Smith**, **Ash Rozendaal**, and **Jonathon Alsop** gambled on a "wide line" to the left of Rabbit Island.

This move was the winning stroke. By finding the offshore bumps early, they carried superior momentum into the mid-section of the race.

- **Johno Smith (OC1)** leveraged this line to split the V1 favorites, clinching **2nd Overall** in the Outrigger category.
- **Ash Rozendaal (OC1)** dominated the Open Men's Solo division, winning his category by nearly 6 seconds.
- **Jonathon Alsop (Ski)** used the deep water lines to secure a comfortable win in the 40-49 Men's division.

## V1 vs OC1: A Tactical Battle

As expected, **Manutea Millon** delivered a powerhouse performance on the **V1** to claim the overall title. **Tupuria King** (V1) rounded out the top three. However, the performance of the day was undoubtedly **Johno Smith** on his **OC1**; holding off elite V1 paddlers in those conditions proved that local knowledge and a perfect line can trump craft type.

History was made in the youth categories. Under the new Waka Ama NZ rules, 14-year-old **Lochlan Te'o** became the youngest finisher in event history. Meanwhile, **Gene Prato** (Ski), **Rebecca Cole** (Women's Ski), and **Jasmin Stevenson** (Women's OC) all celebrated significant victories in their respective fields.
