HIKOI TO POWHIRI LOCATION

- All whanau to start walking down Te Ara o Moerangi towards the lakefront and take a seat on the terraces facing the lake
 - Kawē mate and Trophies will lead the ope of Manuhiri to the lakefront,
 - Wahine to follow closely, Tane to follow behind
 - Kaikorero to follow wahine and take a seat on the Pae chairs provided below the terraces.
 - Kaikorero to sit in speaker order from left to right

9:30- 10:30AM

POWHIRI - OPENING CEREMONY

- Te Arawa Waka will open with a paddle presentation
 - Kaikorero from manawhenua to open the ceremony.
 - Once the manawhenua speaker and waiata is complete
 - Manuhiri Kaikorero will speak, one after the other from left to right
 - After each Kaikorero, you will follow with a waiata tautoko
 - Kaikorero from Haukainga will finally end with a karakia to open the event for the week.
 - Kaikorero from the taha manuhiri will approach the pae, to share a hariru and hongiri.



KAUMATUA AND KURA

- o There is a Taunga waka for kaumatua - (see map for reference)
- o All of Haukainga to make their way to powhiri area- utilising te ara hikoi o te haukainga
- o Identify Kaikorero Timata and Whakamutunga
- o x1 Kaikorero who will speak on behalf Haukainga, Whenua and Mihi Whakatau manuhiri
- o x1 kaikorero whakamutunga Karakia
 - Waiata Tautoko - **Kaore te aroha, Tiroiro ki taku tau**

9:10 - 9.25AM MANUHIRI WHAKAEKE

- o All will enter the Powhiri by Te Ara whakaeke o nga manuhiri, they will all then be seated. (see map for reference)

9:30- 10:30AM POWHIRI - OPENING CEREMONY

- o Te Arawa Waka - Will open with a Karakia and a couple of chants on the wai. Putatara will be blown to signify the start and finish to signal completion.
- o Kaikorero from Manawhenua to open the ceremony followed by a waiata (**Kaore te Aroha**)
 - Manuhiri Kaikorero will speak, one after the other from your (right to left)
 - After each Kaikorero from the taha manuhiri they will follow with a waiata tautoko
 - 3 speakers max from manuhiri
 - Kaikorero kaupapa are : On behalf of all Manuhiri and Kawe mate, Trophies and Tahiti.
- o Kaikorero from manawhenua will close off the Powhiri followed by waiata (**Tiroiro ki taku tau**)
- o Kaikorero from the taha manuhiri will approach the manawhenua pae and share a hariru and hongiri
