RACE DAY INFORMATION

Car Parking: Parking is available inside the venue behind the Ngā Hau Maiangi building as well as street parking. Please note all parking is under Auckland Council management, you will need to read the signs and park accordingly. There is strictly **NO** parking past the island/roundabout.

Food: We encourage you to bring your own healthy kai.

Toilets: Toilets are located under the Ngā Hau Maiangi building.

First Aid: First Aid will be available at the registration tent.

Rubbish/Recycling: We encourage you to please take what you bring. However, there are council rubbish bins at the venue. Please note these are small bins only.

Alcohol/Smokefree: Alcohol, smoking, vaping and any other substance use is not permitted at this event, including all premises of the event.

WAKA DROP OFF & SAFETY CHECKS

Safety Checks:

- All waka will have to pass a safety check and be marked before racing. Any boats not marked will not be permitted to race.
- **Life Jackets are compulsory for all tamariki.**

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- All waka must be Safety Checked
- All taitamariki and intermediate age divisions **must wear life jackets**
- All Juniors must have the following safety equipment for their races:
 - PFD - Personal Floatation Device (per person)
 - Spare Paddle - 2 for a W6

INDIVIDUAL & TEAM WAIVERS

- Team waivers must be completed by all paddlers/teams
- All paddlers U18 must have their waiver signed by their parent/guardian
